Short Description: Unicode and Studio 5 support

Full Description: LDAP now support Studio 4 and 5 Unicode versions.
A new unicode command "LDAP USE UTF8" has been added.
This command is used to tell the LDAP external to use UTF8 encoding when communicating with an LDAP server. The unicode external defaults to true.
For LDAP version 3 compliant servers this option should be set to true even when using the non-unicode version of Omnis.
