I use this code.

Everything looks fine. But when the label prints it prints with approx..75 left margin. If I back off the docs margin setting to 0 then it cuts off the first couple characters on the left side of the label and begins printing at the same location. It's not that the printer has a hard left margin at this position. My standard Omnis reports can start at the left in as little as .15 margin.

Comments : This issue was caused by a change made for case 1125 in OWrite version 3.1.0. We have applied an additional change that should correct this issue and still maintain the correct functionality for case 1125.
