ID : 1845**Fixed in version :** 4.2.0.0**Short Description:** \$gsetstartdate conflict with horizontal scroll**Full Description:** we are encountering an unexpected behavior with the \$gsetstartdate method on macOS.

If we call \$gsetstartdate to horizontally scroll to the selected activity of the treelist, the view is correctly adjusted, but then, if the user clicks the horizontal scrollbar, the view scrolls back to the original date.

Step to reproduce (with the attached library):

1. select an activity from the treelist
2. press the toolbar "Go To Phase" toolbar button
3. click on the horizontal scrollbar
