

## Using “Load page setup” with PDFWriter

Calling load page setup can cause problems when printing to PDFWriter. The most common symptom is that the document is printed to another printer. Under some circumstances, Omnis appears to revert back to printing to the default printer.

The following example code demonstrates the most reliable method of calling “Load page setup” when printing to PDFWriter.

```
;; load page setup before doing anything else
Set report name YourPageSetupReport
Load page setup

;; remember previous printer
Calculate PreviousPrinter as sys(101)

;; prepare for PDF printing (start the PDF job and select the printer)
PDFstartJob
PDFgetPrinterName (PrinterName)
Select printer {[PrinterName]} ;; NOTE: do NOT check Discard previous settings

;; now you can setup other stuff i.e. PDFsetWatermark, etc. followed by
PDFsetDefaultConfig

;; setup file name etc.
PDFsetDefaultFileName("Your file name")
PDFsetFileNameOptions("3")

;; print the report
Send to printer
Set report name YourReportToPrint
Print report

;; finish PDF printing
PDFendJob
Select printer (Discard previous settings) {[PreviousPrinter]}
```
